



## **APPLY FOR Further Education and Training Certificate: Film and Television Production Operations NQF Level 4 Training programme WITH THE KWAZULU-NATAL FILM COMMISSION.**

The KwaZulu-Natal Film Commission (KZNFC) is an entity established in terms of the KwaZulu-Natal Film Commission Act, 2010. The Commission has been set up with its main vision being to position KwaZulu-Natal as a globally competitive, diverse and sustainable industry and choice film destination.

### **Background**

The KZN Film Commission aims to enhance the economy by providing and encouraging opportunities for persons, especially from disadvantaged communities to enter and participate in the film industry in the province. In so doing, it aims to contribute to an enabling environment to job creation and transformation. A baseline study was conducted in 2015 highlighting the skills gap in the KZN industry. The KZNFC is responding to the need for skills in **Technical Production Training programme. The full qualification is the Further Education and Training Certificate: Film and Television Production Operations NQF Level 4 Training programme and is a one-year full time course.**

This qualification is aimed at learners who wish to enter the film and television industry with no prior competence in the area. Learning towards this qualification allows the learner to experience the various career options in the industry (technical, creative and production) and thereby make an informed choice. In addition, it allows learners to focus on and gain entry-level competence in a chosen area of specialisation. This qualification will equip learners with a minimum competence in all focus areas as well as providing an employable level of competence in their choice of focus area.

This Training will be held in Newcastle and is applicable for participants who reside in KwaZulu-Natal.

### **Requirements**

- Candidate must be over the ages of 16 years.
- Candidate must come from a previously disadvantage background and preference is given to Women, Youth and People with disabilities.
- Ability to read, write and be computer literate.
- Work experience is advantageous

1. A motivation (maximum 2 pages) explaining why you should be considered for the programme
2. Your CV
3. A copy of your latest qualifications. Please note that you require a minimum of a NQF Level 3 or Grade 11 to apply.
4. Certified copy of your ID.
