Call for Panel: Appeals Committee

Background

The KwaZulu-Natal Film Commission (KZNFC) launched its Film Fund in July 2014. The Fund is for the development and production of television, feature films, short films, animation and documentary content and television series. The Film Fund also caters for Marketing and Distribution, Audience Development and Markets and Festivals.

As part of KZNFC's objectives and in the interest of transparency and openness, the KZNFC is establishing an Appeals Committee that will deal with all the appeals emanating from the decisions taken on Film Fund applications.

The KZNFC is therefore seeking suitable external industry members to serve on the Appeals Committee to consider appeals as and when the need arises.

Please note that this is not an advertisement for permanent employment.

Purpose

The KwaZulu Natal Film Commission (KZNFC) is calling for seasoned TV / Film professionals who are able or experienced in evaluating applications for funding.

A member of the panel shall hold office for a period not exceeding two years. S/he may be re-appointed on the panel after the term has expired.

The individual should be easily accessible to the KZNFC, through electronic means or face to face interactions.

Qualification and experience

- Film/TV graduate with at least 5 years of experience, producing 2 documentaries or 1 -2 feature films or 2 animation projects or 1 – 2 TV series or;
- If not a graduate, the professional must have at least 10 years of experience, producing 2 documentaries or 1 – 2 feature films or 2 animation projects or 1 – 2 TV series.
- 2 years' experience in dealing with the requirements of a Film Fund or;
- 3 years' experience in a broadcast commissioning role.



Interested individuals are required to submit:

- A motivation (maximum 2 pages) as to why you should be considered to the Appeals Committee.
- A CV with detailed profile, with detailed experience and competency in relation to achieving the respective services, together with 3 traceable references.
- Industry specific qualifications, where applicable.

Members of industry that are currently on the panel of evaluators for the KZNFC are not eligible to apply for the appeals panel as the panel is to be independent of the review process.
