Background

The KwaZulu-Natal Film Commission (KZNFILM) launched its Film Fund in July 2014. The Fund is for Post Production of television, feature films, short films, animation, and documentary content. The Film Fund also caters for Marketing and Distribution, Audience Development and Markets and Festivals.

The vision of the KZNFILM is to position KwaZulu-Natal as a globally competitive, diverse, and sustainable industry and choice film destination. The Film Fund is designed to stimulate the economy in the film and TV Industry and supporting industries. With the KZN industry being a distant third to Gauteng and Western Cape in terms of market size, it is important to grow the industry from within while attracting lucrative productions from outside the province.



Required documents for a successful application

- One-page motivation letter indicating what the post production funding will be utilised for.
- Synopsis
- **Narrative Treatment** (to include logline, genre and target audience)
- Detailed Production budget with KZN expenditure per line item.
- **Detailed production schedule**
- A full script for feature projects and scripts for all episodes for TV series
- A comprehensive distribution and marketing plan with signed distribution Letter of Commitment and/or contract; from a reputable distributor which details the deal terms, i.e. duration (not more than 7 years), the distributors company details, the affected regions; and the distribution plan for recoupment of the full film investment. By distributors, KZNFilm refers to community, local and global free-to-air and DTT broadcasters, streamers, online platforms like YouTube, among others.
- A detailed financial plan with letters of commitment or contract. Please include the details of various co-funders, and whether funding has been committed or pending.
- **Detailed key creative team CV**
- **SARS Tax Clearance Certificate or Tax PIN**
- Certified ID copy (valid for 6 months)
- Company registration documents
- **BBBEE Certificate**
- SBD form

Applications must be submitted with all required documents attached or ZIP folded in a SINGLE email (NO links are to be sent), any additional documents sent separately will not be considered in the evaluation of the project.

Any funding application that is submitted to the KZNFC through any other channel than the email address prescribed in this document will be considered invalid.
