### CALL TO PARTICIPATE AT THE 6<sup>TH</sup> EDITION OF THE DIFF ISIPHETHU PROGRAMME.

The KwaZulu-Natal Film Commission (KZNFilm) is calling for applications from local (KwaZulu-Natal) filmmakers to be part of the KwaZulu-Natal Film Commission's delegation that will be attending the 6<sup>th</sup> Edition of the Durban International Film Festival (DIFF) Isiphethu programme, which is set run alongside DIFF.

KZNFilm is looking for 3 filmmakers from each of the regions of the province namely, Amajuba, eThekwini, Harry Gwala, iLembe, King Cetshwayo, Ugu, Umgugundlovu, Umkhanyakude, Umzinyathi, Uthukela and Zululand.

The 2023 Isiphethu programme is a developmental programme that aims to nurture the tale and expand the base of writers in the province of KwaZulu-Natal. The programme also plays a significant role in the skills development value chain and is a key driver of social transformation and economic empowerment in the film industry.

The KZNFilm's participation at Isiphethu provides an opportunity for young, emerging, community arts filmmakers to have access to the below:

- 1. The isiZulu Scriptwriting Workshop which will take place over a 10-day period at the Centre of Creative Arts, UKZN - which will cover the basics of writing for screen to equip upcoming screenwriters looking to enter the industry.
- 2. The **Industry Development Programme** which includes individual presentations, workshops and panel discussions that explore industry relevant topics.
- 3. The **short film screenings** at the KwaZulu-Natal Society for the Arts (KZNSA) Gallery – which will showcase 30 student films from all over the world.

- Tier 3: New entrants into the industry, particularly recent film school graduates from historically disadvantaged backgrounds.

(Produced short film, 4-7 years in industry, no formal training at NQF level 6, Worked in industry as crew/assistant, Produced Micro-budget film/television/fiction or nonfiction)

**Emergent (B)** 

(Completed degree or 3 national SETA certified diploma PDI Male and female, Recent graduate, Portfolio of Evidence, 0-3 years in industry)
